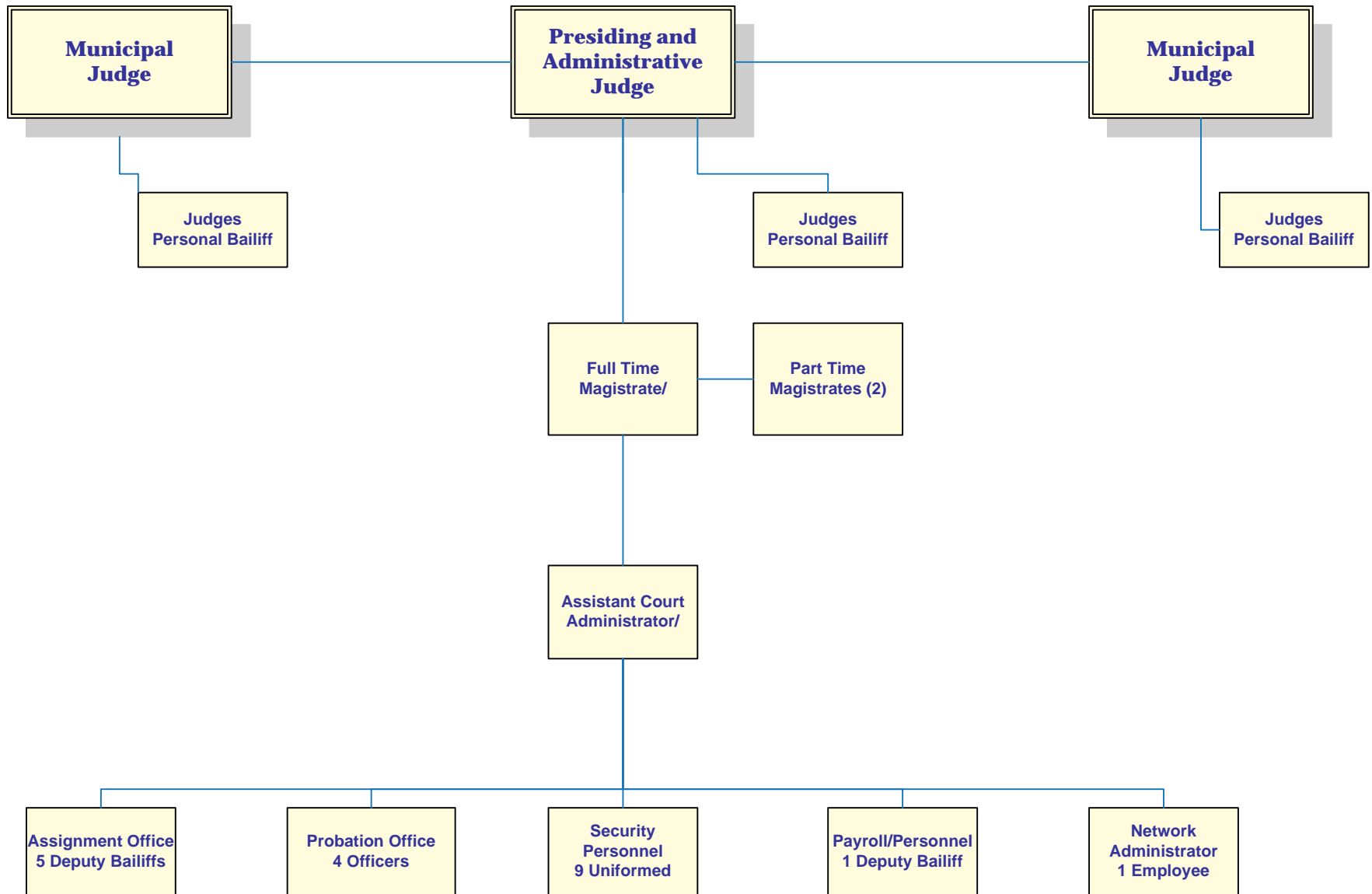

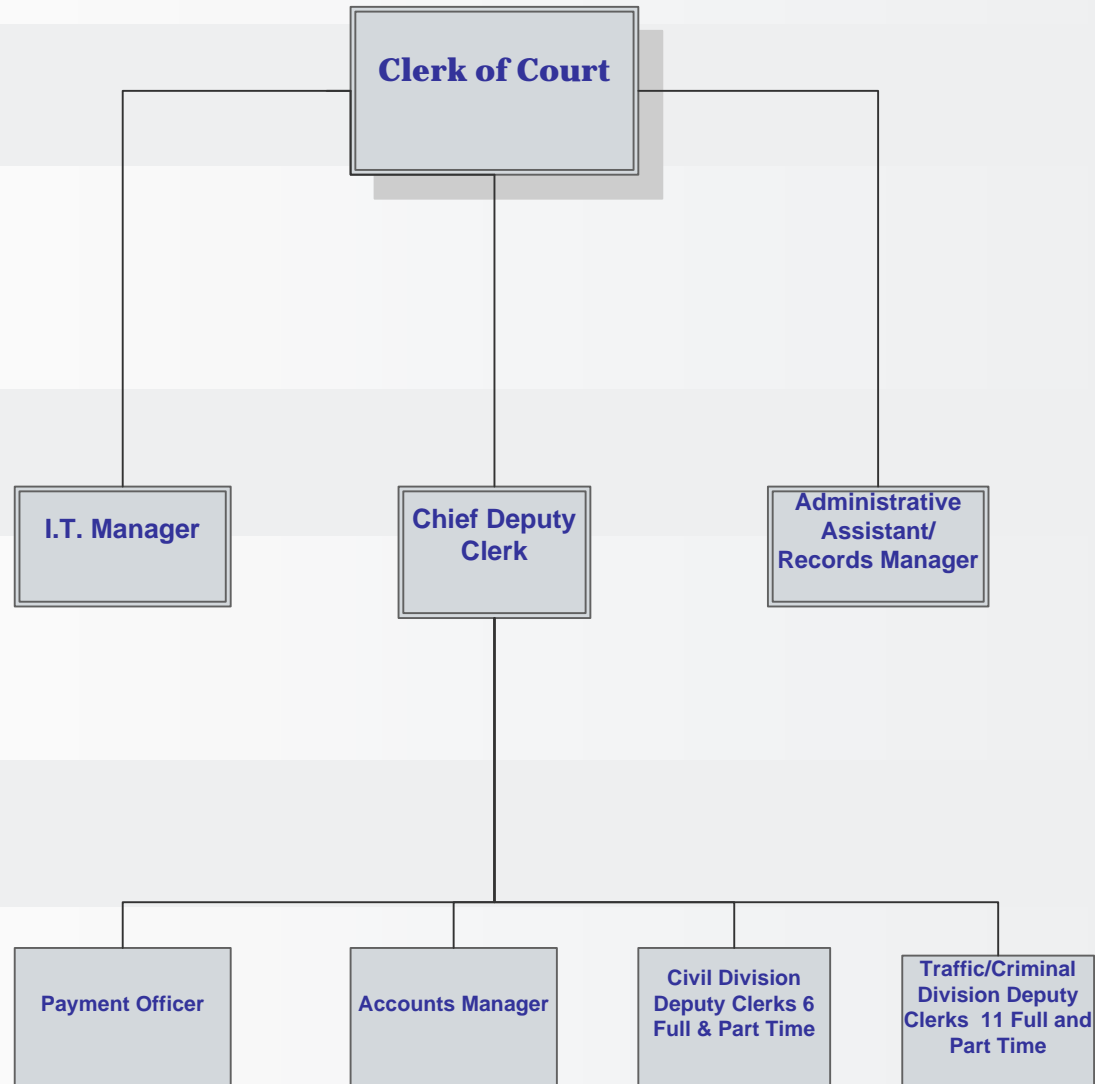
Organization Chart

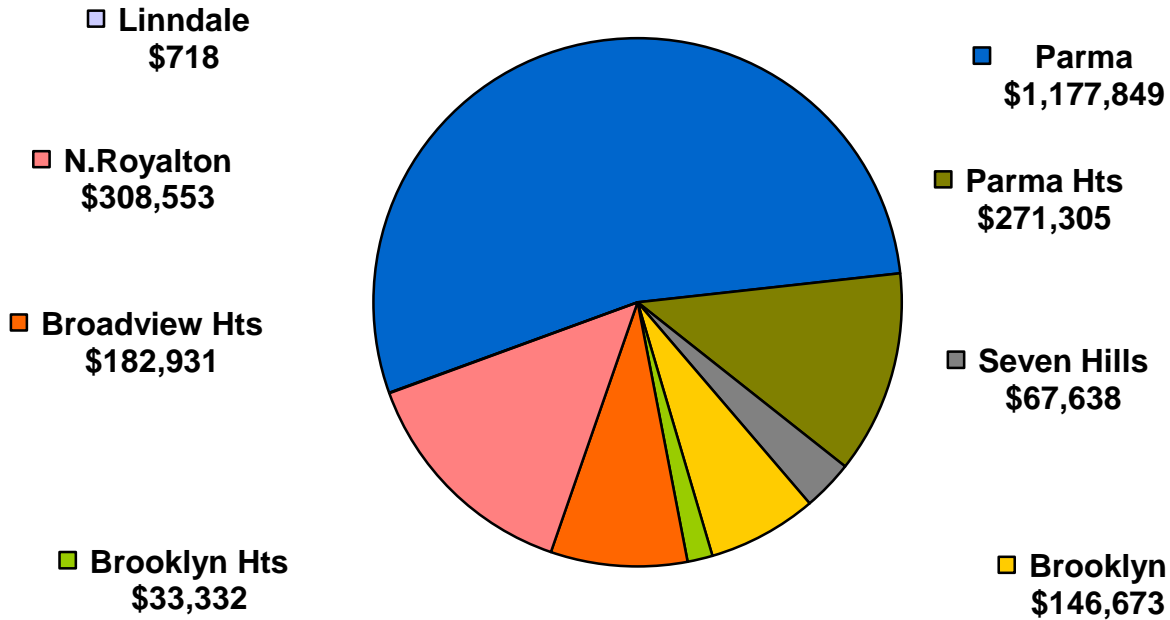

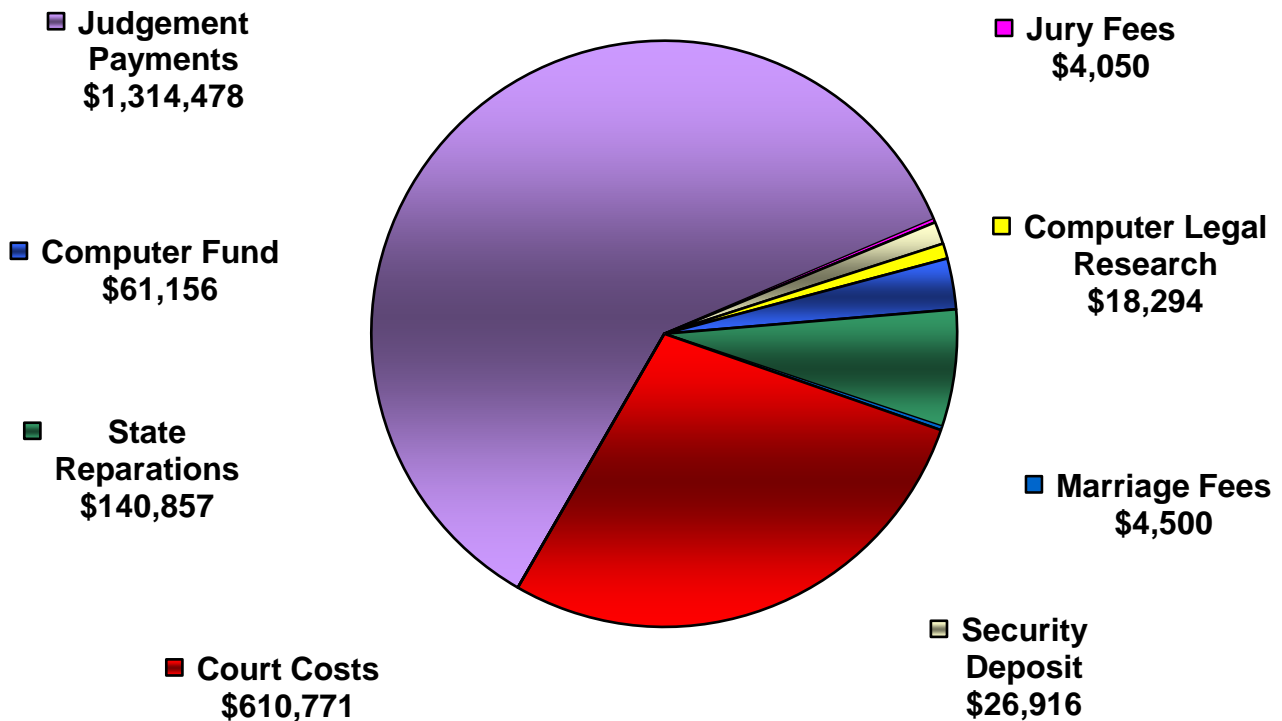

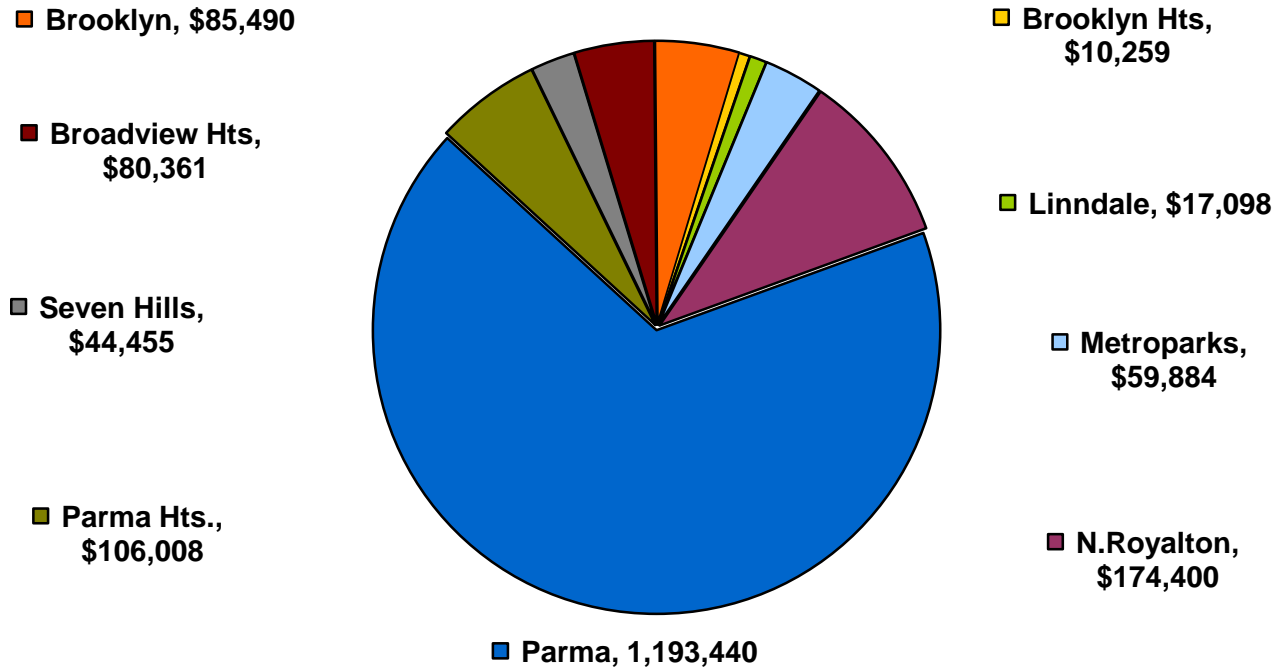
Civil REVENUE by Defendant's Municipality



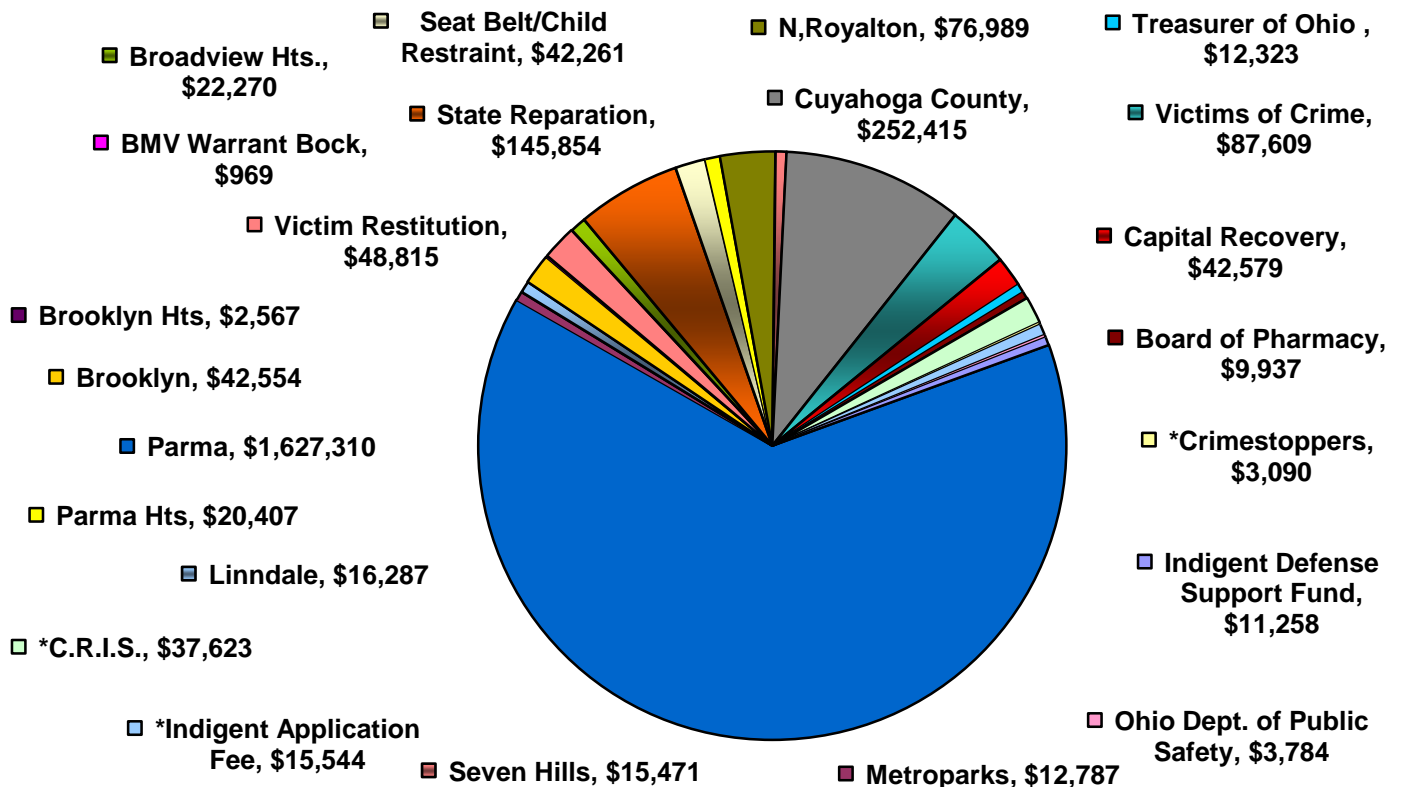
Civil DISBURSEMENTS by Type



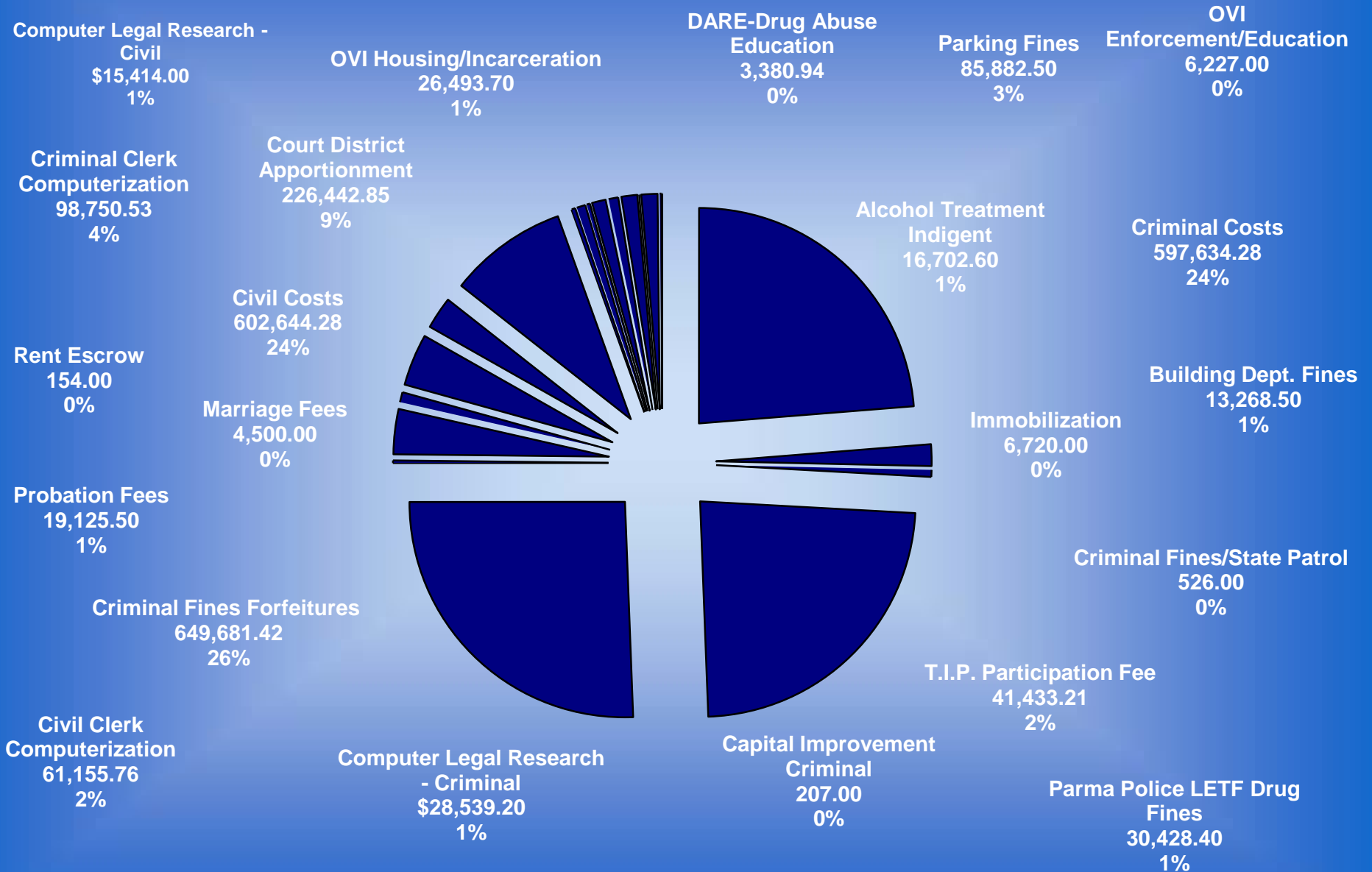
Traffic/Criminal REVENUE by Originating City



Traffic/Criminal DISBURSEMENTS by Agency

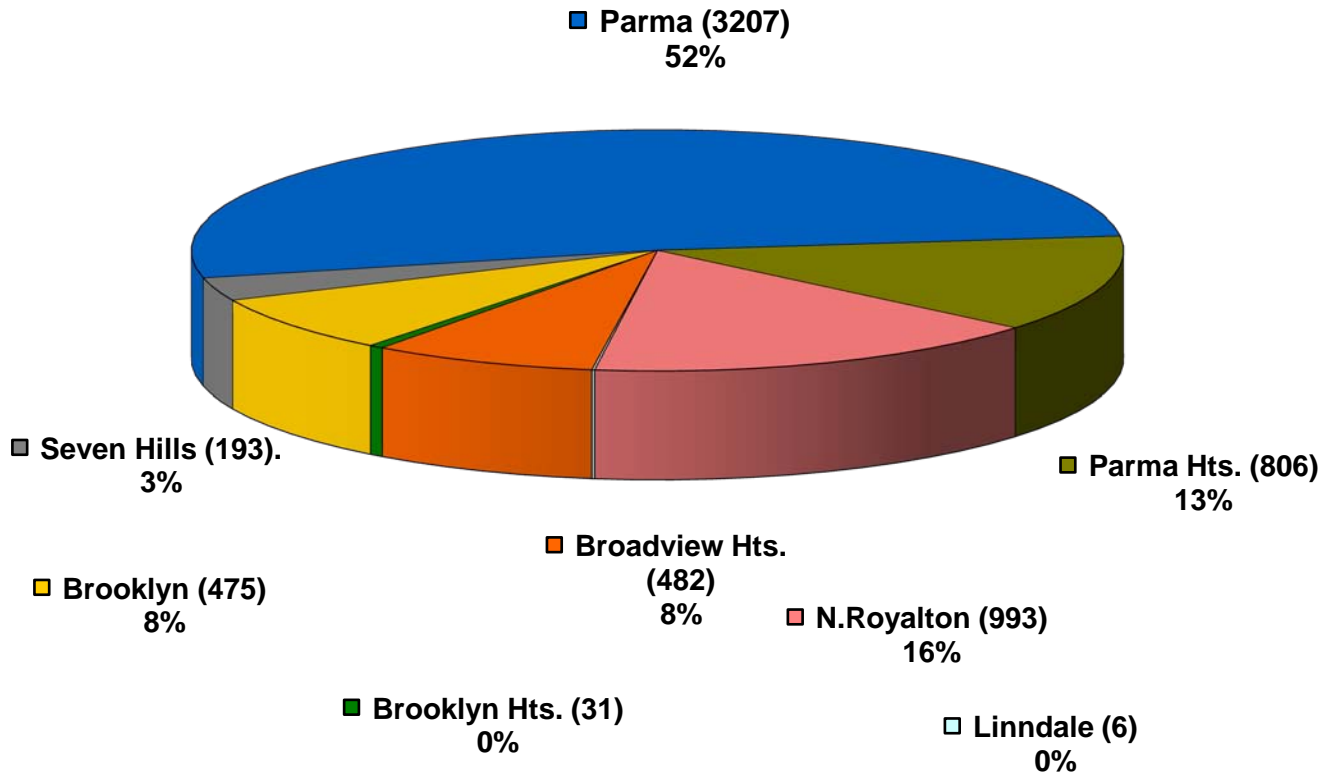

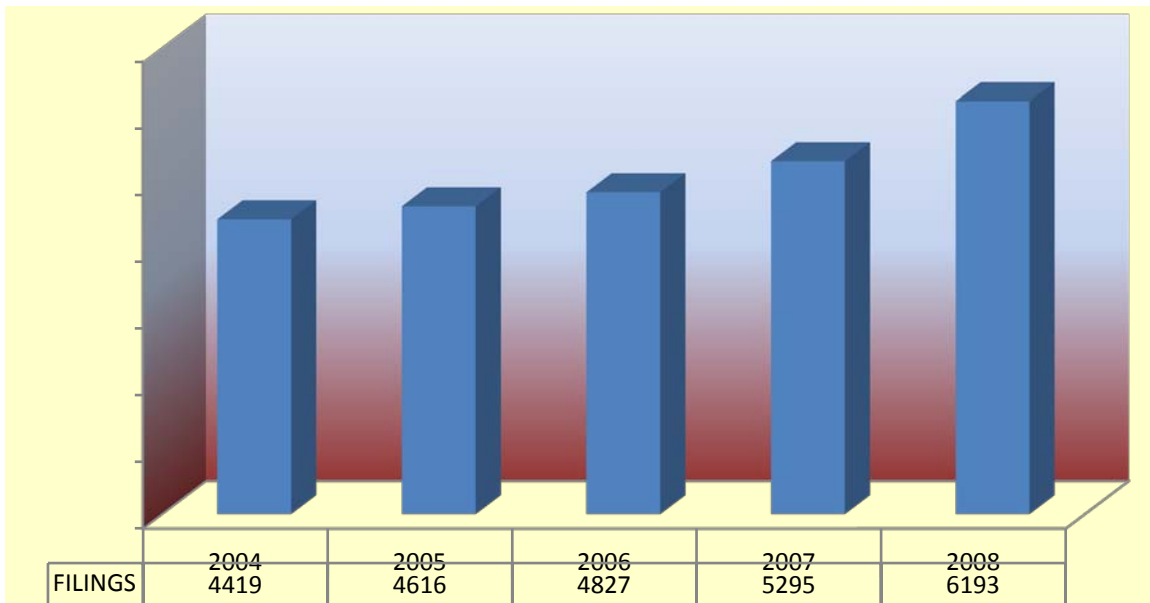

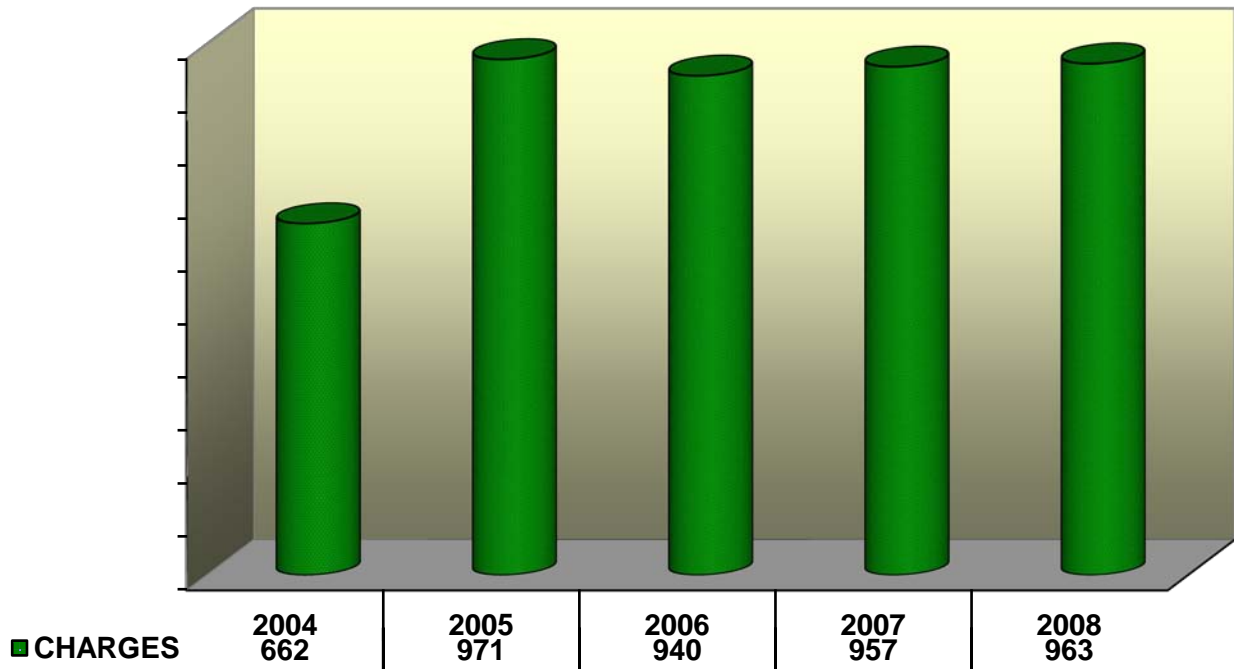

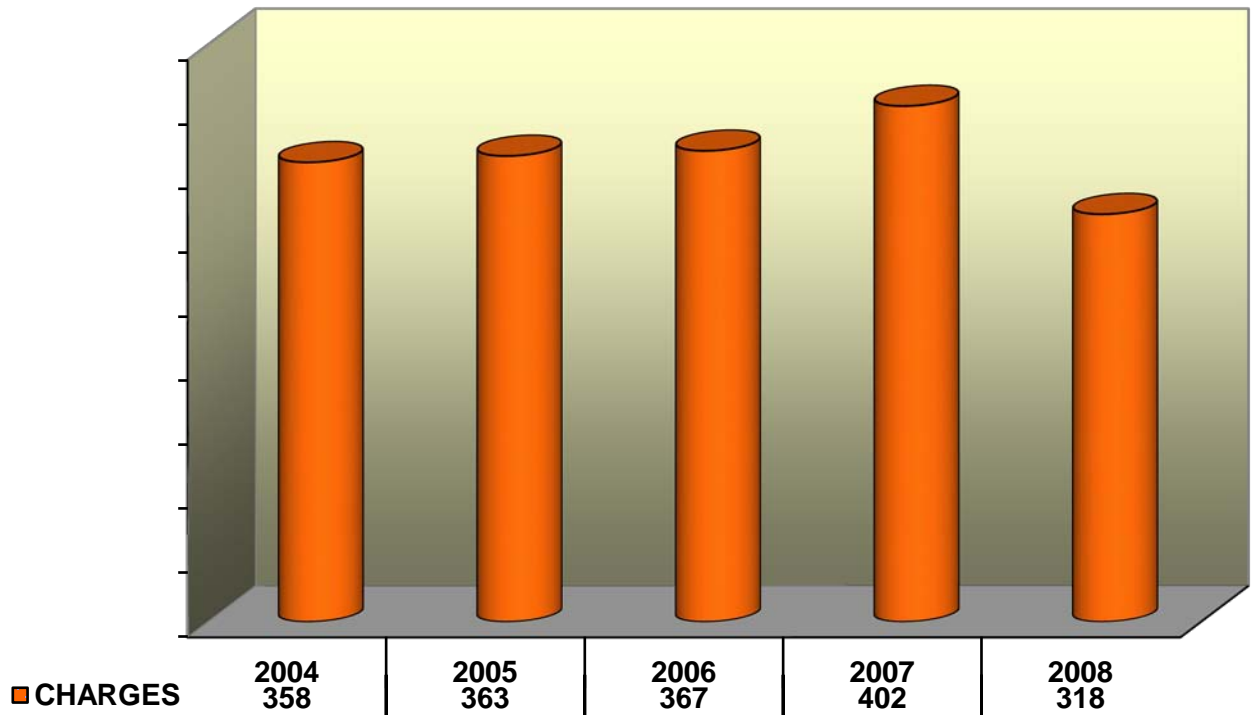

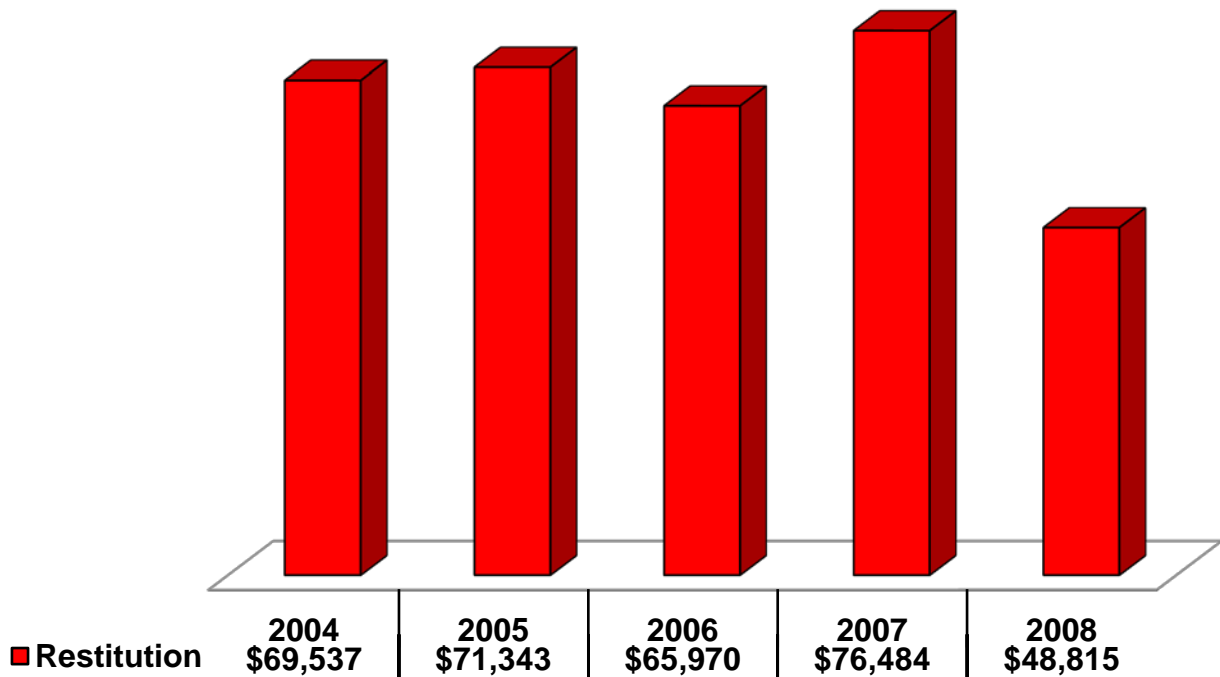
